1. Go to www.mel.org
2. Type your search term in the box then click "Search."



6. Once you've clicked on the "Get this from MeLCat" button, you will need to input your Library Card Information. This includes:

- Home Library — Port Austin Township Library
- Name — Your full name —
example: Jane Doe
- Library Card Number — located on the back of your card under the barcode —
example: 1234567899

7. Click the "Submit" button to complete your order. A screen will pop up confirming your order. Items can take between 1-2 weeks to arrive at your home library. Once it arrives, a library employee will give you a call to let you know.
